Work activities – whereabouts

As you are aware London is a densely populated and diverse city where criminal incidents can occur. There may be times when these incidents impact on works for the Thames Tunnel over the duration of the project and require a project representative to contact you with instant advice/communication.

To ensure that we make contact with those nearest to a known incident, the Thames Tunnel project operates a whereabouts system. This system assists the project to coordinate activities across all locations and helps us in a situation that may require us to immediately get in touch with people working on behalf of the project.

Please ensure that all your employees register their whereabouts via this established system. If you are unsure whether your team's whereabouts is being included or would like more information about the system, please contact your project representative.

All works packages have a project Engineering Site Incident Control (ESIC) form that details key contacts. This will be used by your Thames Tunnel supervisors and management so that you can cascade information to your team.
