



Case Studies

Recently at a GBM site a person tried to gain access, announcing themselves as being from the Environment Agency wanting to take photographs. This person was asked for their ID, and on being asked left.

Required Actions/Preventative Measures

- 1 All site manager / supervisors should ensure all persons entering site show identification.
- 2 Check that the photograph matches the person presenting the card.
- 3 A genuine person should be happy to provide you with contact details in order to verify any concerns.
- 4 Take vehicle registration numbers where applicable and write a description of the suspected character.
- 5 Report any suspected fake identities attempting to enter a site to the client.
- 6 Where the suspect loiters or is spotted around the perimeter of the site telephone the police.
