

Environment Policy Statement



GBM is committed to a policy of effectively managing environmental performance in order to minimise the impact of our business processes on the natural environment and the community at large. This commitment extends to all workplaces, employees and others affected by our operations.

Our objective is to integrate the assessment, management and control of environmental issues into the management of our projects. We will:

- Assess the environmental aspects of our operations during planning, design and implementation phases to minimise potential environmental impact and to prevent pollution of the external environment.
- Ensure compliance with all relevant environmental legislation and other environmental-related obligations including approved codes of practice and requirements specified by our clients.
- Develop and implement objectives and targets to achieve continual improvement in our environmental performance.
- Carry out work with due consideration for local residents and ecology.
- Consult with all relevant stakeholders to ensure environmental awareness and to encourage feedback.
- Incorporate sustainable environmental considerations into our design standards and construction practices having particular regard to energy and water consumption, use of low environmental impact materials and waste minimisation.
- Ensure that all employees are aware of the environmental implications of their job role and that they receive training appropriate to the potential environmental risk.
- Promote the adoption of good environmental practices by our suppliers and subcontractors;

The GBM Joint Venture Board has the overall responsibility for environmental management. The Board will discharge this responsibility with the assistance the GBM Senior Leadership Team, management, employees and the supply chain. The Joint Venture Board accepts its responsibility for environmental management and will ensure that resources, facilities, finances, information, instruction, training and supervision are provided, as necessary, to maintain a positive environmental culture and performance.

GBM Senior Leadership Team are responsible for the implementation of this Policy statement and for ensuring environmental risks are assessed and appropriate management controls are implemented in accordance with GBM standards, contained in the Business Management System.

All employees and contractors are required to co-operate with GBM in the implementation of the Environmental Policy will ensure that their own work, so far as is reasonably practicable, is carried out with minimum risk to the environment.

This Policy statement will be displayed at all workplaces and made available to the public and other interested parties upon request. The Environmental Policy document, describing the system in place, will also be available at all workplaces for reference.

The Environmental Policy document is continually monitored, formally reviewed annually and amended as required by changes in legislation or work practices.
