



## Summary of Contractor H&S Leadership Team Meeting 9<sup>th</sup> January 2012

**Location: TW Training room, Mogden STW**

The HSLT invited members from both Black and Veatch and Thames Water to join us for an informal chat during our tea break. It was a good opportunity for HSLT members to engage with the site teams and was well received by those who attended.

Below is a summary of the discussions that took place during the meeting:

- **HSLT** – All members were asked their views on the structure of the HSLT and to confirm their personal commitment.
- **Awards** – 68 entries have been received for the 'Excellence in H&S Awards 2011/12'. Judging will take place on 2<sup>nd</sup> Feb and winners announced at the conference on 15<sup>th</sup> March.
- **H&S conference** – the next conference will be based around the theme of 'zero compromise'. The agenda will include 2 external speakers one of whom is Lawrence Waterman, Head of Health and Safety, Olympic Delivery Authority.

- **Inspirational Leadership** – it was confirmed that this programme is designed primarily for supervisors with line management responsibility. Other attendees such as Project Managers and Engineers will not see as much benefit from attending

If we are to realise our vision of zero harm, zero accidents, zero compromise we must have safe conditions. We would like to encourage all contractors and Thames Water staff to either sort or report hazards.
- **Stand Down moment** – Cappagh Browne will be holding a stand down moment on 20<sup>th</sup> Jan, following the tragic death of Fred marsh last year. The stand down which is in the form of a briefing will remind everyone of some simple key messages to ensure that we all stay safe on site.
