

GBM / GB JV

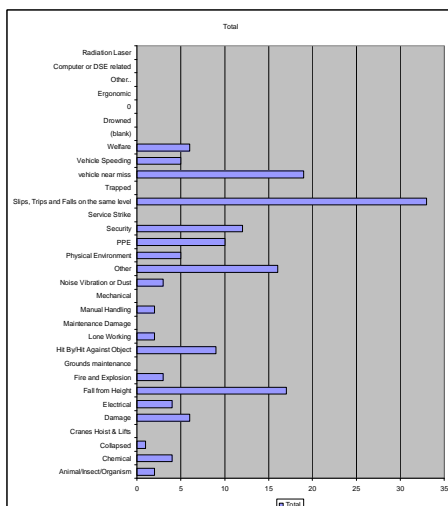
